

Grade 3 Vocabulary

Bishop: is a leader of a diocese, and chief teachers of the Catholic Church.

Catholic: means “universal”.

Christian: a person who is baptized follows Jesus

Deacon: a person who was ordained to serve the parish community in many ways.

Disciple: a person who chose to follow Jesus.

Evangelist: another name for a Gospel writer.

Holy Spirit: the third Person of the Trinity.

Immortal soul: the spiritual part of every person; it is created by god.

Liturgical year: the celebration in the liturgy of events in the life of Jesus.

Messiah: it means “anointed” Jesus was the Messiah.

New Testament: the second part of the Bible that tells the life and teachings of Jesus, his followers, in the early Church.

Paschal Candle: special candle used on Holy Saturday, during the Easter season, at baptisms and funerals.

Paschal Mystery: the passion, death, Resurrection and Ascension of Jesus.

Pope: successor of Peter. Leader of the universal Catholic Church.

Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. These three days celebrate Jesus’ passion, death and Resurrection.

Vocation: we are called to use our talents to carry on Christ’s mission in the world.
