We only have a couple of weeks of school left this year! Next week, graduation week, is a special week for our 8th graders. Please note the information for parents about graduation day.

Information for Parents of Students in Grades Preschool-Grade 6!

June 8th is graduation day. Students in preschool-grade 6 do not have school that day. Everyone is invited to attend the Graduation Mass at 7 pm in the church and the reception following in the parish hall. Students will have school on June 9.

Information for Parents of 7th and 8th Graders!

Graduation Breakfast, June 8, 9 am—8th graders, parents of 8th graders, faculty and staff, and 7th graders attend the breakfast. (Siblings and other family members do not attend the breakfast.) Seventh and eighth graders need to come to school at the regular time, 8:30. All other students have the day off. The breakfast begins at 9 am in the parish hall and runs until about 11:15. Seventh graders who are not in the choir should be picked up right after the breakfast.

Following the breakfast, the 8th graders will go to the church for a short graduation rehearsal. The Select Choir and students giving speeches will practice after the rehearsal and be released for the rest of the day.

Individual graduation photos begin at 5:15. Students will be assigned a photo time. The class photo will be taken at 6:30 on the steps in front of the church. Family and friends are invited to the Graduation Mass.

All accounts (tuition, fundraising, service time, and stewardship) should be current/cleared prior to the last day of school. Report cards will be sent home the week of June 19th.
